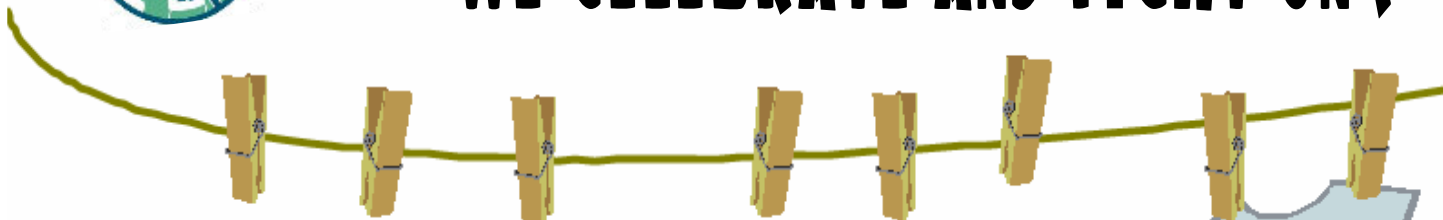




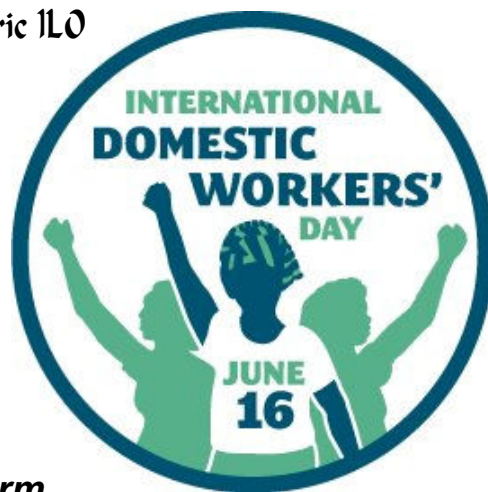
WE CELEBRATE AND FIGHT ON!
