We also call for dialogue among all democratic forces in Bolivia; it is necessary for their commitment and firmness with democratic values to overcome this situation with social peace and unity. Democracy guarantees respect for the Constitution, legal procedures, and the security of its citizens.

As international and Latin American organizations representing women domestic workers, we reaffirm our commitment to democracy as a space that creates conditions to fight for and ensure the guarantee of workers' rights, particularly their fundamental rights such as freedom of work, freedom of association, and equality and non-discrimination.

In this context, we remind that decent work is conceived and realized in democracy, which allows for the well-being of workers, families, and society.
